After the report of Comrade Schwernik, on "The tasks of the Treds - Unions in the Reconstruction Period", Compade Pedmore on behalf of the Negro Delegates to the Congress delivered the following speech:*

This is for the purpose of depriving the Soviet Union of an export merket. All of these, comrades, are tendencies leading towards war.

Therefore, the question is, how can we Negro workers heat prepare ourselves to defend the Soviet Usion, our Fatherland. We must adopt more energetically methods to strengthen our working class pressionistions: we must continue to develop and faster the spirit of internetionalism and ourselves; we must takes greater interest in the movement of the working class not only of the metropoliten countries, but slep of the calabial countries.
