James Ford Anwers Padmore's Charges

NEW YORK, July 31.—Charges that George Padmore, reaently expelled from the Communist party, has by his action placed himself in the ranks of the enemies of the Negro liberation struggle, are contained in a statement made public this week by James W. Ford, outstanding Communist leader.

Ford's statement comes in answer to an "Open Letter ...nich Padmore recently sent to the Negro press. The statement reviews the reasons for Padmore's expulsion, and accuses him of placing intellectual weapons "in the hands of hundreds of avowed enemies of the Negro people."

Ford was himself the chief founder of the Interctional Trade Union Committee of Negro. Workers. He is a member of the Central Committee of the Communist Party, and was candidate for vice-president on the Communist ticket in the 1932 elections. He is now Harlem organizer of the Party.

The Amsterdam News has already given prominent space to the lies and slanders sent out by Padmore, burying in a small space

The statement of Bord follows in full:

George Padmore, who has been expelled from the Communist Party, has sent broadcast a statement which is a bifter attack against our Party and upon its program. This letter Mr. Padmore has placed in the hands of hundreds of avowed enemies of the Party and the Negro people.

Aid to the Enemy

The Communist Party is not surprised at the accusations of Mr. Padmore: We expect calumny and slander from our enemies; it is one of the gauges of the effectiveness of our work. We answer Mr. Padmore's statements, because we know that his attack will be seized on by every enemy of the liberation struggle, will be received with the greatest joy by the white lynchers, the Klansmen, the whole white ruling class, and will be used by them to try to drive the Negro masses away from the Communist Party. What better weapon can the white ruling-class ask, than such a document as this from the hands of Mr. Padmore, slandering and vilifying the organization which they hate and fear because it stands fearlessly for the freedom of the Negro people?

1) Padmore was on intimate terms with well-known spies and police agents within the ranks of the Party and other workingclass organizațions. Although re peatedly informed of the fact that these associates of his were spies against the workers, he nevertheless refused to break with

Helped Imperialism in Liberia

2) Padmore's political views and activities around the question of Liberia were in a direction calculated to further enslave and degrade the already downtrodden n es of that country. Instead of Jeing the "last stronghold of Negro freedom," as Mr. Padmore says, Liberia is in actual fact a wassal, state, of, American imperialism. In this rape of Liberia, Harvey Firestone and other American capitalists have found their best allies and servants in the Liberian government officials. The government of Liberia, puppet of Wall Street has been nothing more or less than local policeman, slave-driver, Jand-thief and recruiter of forced abor for American imperialism. Yet Mr. Padmore has taken active part in the so-called American-Liberian Plan of Cooperation, which would give aupport to this very government, this agent of Wall Street. Mr. Padmore has rejected completely the Communist policy, that Liberia and its native people must be freed in the process of bitter struggle against those native forces which support foreign imperialism and against imperialism.

Rejects Unity of Workers

3) Mr. Padmore has likewise rejected one of the most fundamental principles of Communism that the white working-class and the oppressed colonial peoples and nations are natural allies in the struggle against the common oppressor, the ruling-class. He claims that white and black can never understand one another. Thus he follows the policy of the ruling-class, to whom the fear of unity between white slave and black slave is one perpetual nightmare. Mr. Padmore accepts, in effect, the idea of the white ruling-class that between black and white there is an inherent and lasting antagonism.

In order to conceal his own desertion, his own treachery, Mr. Padmore charges the Communist Party and the Communist International with desertion of the Negro liberation struggle end treachery to the Negro people.

How low Mr. Padmore has fallen, is shown when he makes in his "Open Letter" the vile threat to bring legal action against Comrade Huiswoud, another Negro Communist, for having written an article against him. He, who once had pretensions to be a Communist, would go into the courts of the white rulers; he would ask that they vindicate him; he would bring his case into the tribunals of the oppressors; he would run whining to the slave-drivers and ask that they be the "impartial arbiters" of this dispute! Can submission to the ruling class go further than this?

Padmore Distorts Facts

Mr. Padmore distorts facts in the most shameful manner. He says that the Communist International abolished the International Trade Union Committee of Negro

lieves himself to be the committee! He is removed, therefore the committee is abolished! What is the truth? This committee was founded by militant Negro workers from all countries, and I myself took active part in its work from the beginning. It has never been abolished: on the contrary it is hard at work today, and its organ, the Negro Worker, is being published as before. What is true is that George Padmore was removed from this committee because he no longer carried out the policy which the committee had set itself. Instead of a line of uncompromising struggle with all imperialism, with all forces that grind down the Negro masses, he passed over to a policy of compromise with imperialism and its agents.

Padmore says that after fifteen years, the Communist Party has been unable to make headway among the Negro masses. His wish is father to his thought; along with the white ruling-class, Padmore sincerely wishes that this were so. But the thousands of Negroes joining the ranks of the Communist Parties, fighting for liberation under its leadership, give the lie to this accusation. Because the Communist Party lives, the nine Scottsboro boys were not sent to their deaths three years ago, but have become instead, not only here but the world over, the symbol of a fight to the death with the bloody oppressors of the Negro people. Because the Communist Party lives, the Negro masses are in the forefront of the struggle for the liberation of Cuba from the rule of Wall Street. Under the leadership of the Communist Party, the darker peoples in China, In-dia, South Africa are uniting and rising to throw off the yoke of imperialist oppression. In the face of all this, how absurd, how shameless, is the charge of Mr. Padmore, that the Communist International is deserting the struggle for Negro freedom!

Communist Party Needs No Defense

The Communist Party needs no defense as the champion of the oppressed Negro people. Its deeds speak for it. The very hatred of our enemies, the vilification we receive from the white imperialists, the lynchers, the Klansmen this is the finest criterion of the effectiveness of our work. 1) What is the value of mouth washes, sprays, etc., in preventing diseases of the mouth, nose and throat? 2) Does swimming have any harmful effect on diseased sinus?

ANSWERS

Antiseptic m-outh washes such as permanganate of potash, potassium, chlorate. have the effect of less-

tivity of the superficial germs and in killing some of them, but as most of the germs are to be found embedded in the tissues, hence in many cases the effect is not good. Combined with hot water the effect is, however, increased not so much by the drug used, but by the action of the heat which attracts more blood to the area made hot, thus with, an increased amount of blood, there is also an increased activity of the white blood cells of the blood whose function is to destroy invading germs and organism (phagoeytic action); the destruction of the germs in the deeper tissues is carried on by the white calls while the superficial germs are killed by the antiseptic.

Nasal douches and sprays used indiscriminately are apt to be injurious rather than beneficial in that they tend to force infection into the ears and sinuses. They should not be used more than is prescribed by the physician that is two or three times a day. 2. On Swimming.

Some authorities believe that swimming should be avoided, especially during the acute stages of sinusites. Sea water and the disinfecting chlorine in swimming pools tend in some cases to further irritation of the inflamed mucous membrane of the sinuses. Dividing should be strictly avoided as the pressure of the water may force some of the infectious matter in the tube leading to the ear, thus causing a middle ear disease known as "Ohtis Media."
